Ovid, *Ars Amatoria: Book 3*, ed. Christopher M. Brunelle (Oxford University Press, 2014).

Requirements

We will read as much of *Ars amatoria* 3 as we can. The pace will be suited to your abilities; I expect you to spend two hours preparing for each hour of class.

The best dictionary is the *Oxford Latin Dictionary*, which is in the reference collection in the Dabney reading room (PA2365.E5 O9 pts. 1–4 and 5–8), but the next best—and most easily available—is Lewis and Short's *A Latin Dictionary* (<http://logeion.uchicago.edu/index.html>).

A midterm exam is due February 9, at 5 pm, and a final exam, March 14, at 5 pm. The exams are closed book. 30% of your grade will be based on the midterm, 30% on the final, and 40% on class participation.
